1. INTRODUCTION

These rotating sirens are mounted on a steel tower structure. Currently we have 2 of these towers (disassembled) and available at our storage area at Mine site along with some spare sirens.

1.8 Evaluation Criteria

1.9 Changes to Proposals

The proposal submitted is irrevocable by the bidder. Bidders will not be permitted to alter their proposals once they have been submitted.

1.10 Proposal Validity

Proposals are required to be valid for (60) days.

1.12 Alternative Proposals

APPENDIX B SCOPE OF WORKS

CONSTRUCTING OF A SIREN TOWER

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

To be in line with Rosebel Gold Mine pit blasting procedure and awareness compliance, a siren is currently needed at a central location for the north pits at Rosebel Mine site. These rotating sirens are mounted on a steel tower structure. Currently we have 2 of these towers (disassembled) and available at our storage area at Mine site along with some spare sirens.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

2.1 Specific work

A contractor is needed for the construction of a steel angular base along with rebar and all civil works that needs to be done in regards to the base of the tower such as assembly, erection and mounting of one tower that consists of 2 sections.

Below some more details of what is expected:

- Evaluation of the current status of the tower, rectification, missing parts such as bolts.
- Assessment and fabrication of an angular base suitable for the tower which shall be tied into the foundation.
- Provide rebar for the base/ foundation according to the tower specifications.
- Civil works: B25 concrete base 1.8x1.8x2.1 meter.
- Erecting of an angular 2 section tower (approx. 6m X 0.82m X 0.82m each).
- Mounting of the siren (Federal Signal 2001-130) on top of the tower along with a VHF antenna and cabling.
- Mounting of the siren controller on ground level.

2.3 Location

Rosebel Mine site, job will be executed at Tower 3 next to the existing communications tower.

2.3 Start date & period of implementation

2.4 Facilities to be provided by RGM

Onsite accommodation is not guaranteed, feedback and guidelines will follow.

Excavation works.

Lifting and transportation of the tower and other necessary items.

A boom truck or crane with man basket.

A Job safety/hazard analysis that describes job in specific steps shall be completed together with the RGM responsible person.

The IT department - Radio team will provide on the job guidance regarding the specific work to be done.

REQUIREMENTS

3.1 Personnel to be provided by the Contractor

The contractor must provide workers who have a background of tower erections and are experienced in working at heights (valid certification required).

Contractors must have SOR insurance in place. For projects longer than 1 (one) month HCCO medical screening is required.

3.2 Facilities to be provided by the Contractor

The contractor must come with their own tools (hand and/ or power tools), Standard PPE, Fall prevention harnesses with a valid proof of inspection report is required to execute the job. RGM will not provide any type of tools to the contractor.

Light vehicle requirements entering the mine site/ haul roads/ mining pit/TSF area are:

- Flashing/Rotating beacon (Strobe light)
- Seatbelts
- Driver's side airbag
- Fully functional head and tail lights
- Backup Alarm
- Certified ROPS
- Fire extinguisher
- 4WD
- Reflective stripes
- Buggy whip with a minimum 3.8m and maximum 4.1m height from ground level
- Identification number
- Two-way radio
- (Covid related) Transparent dividers if more than 2 persons are traveling a single 2/4 doors light vehicle
