



Figure 1.1 Sarmacca New Camp project design














Figure 1.4 layout gym/workout area






Figure 1.5 layout of generator location






Figure 1.6 layout oil-water separator of generator pad






Figure 1.7 layout of recreational hall






Figure 1.8 layout of laundry room
